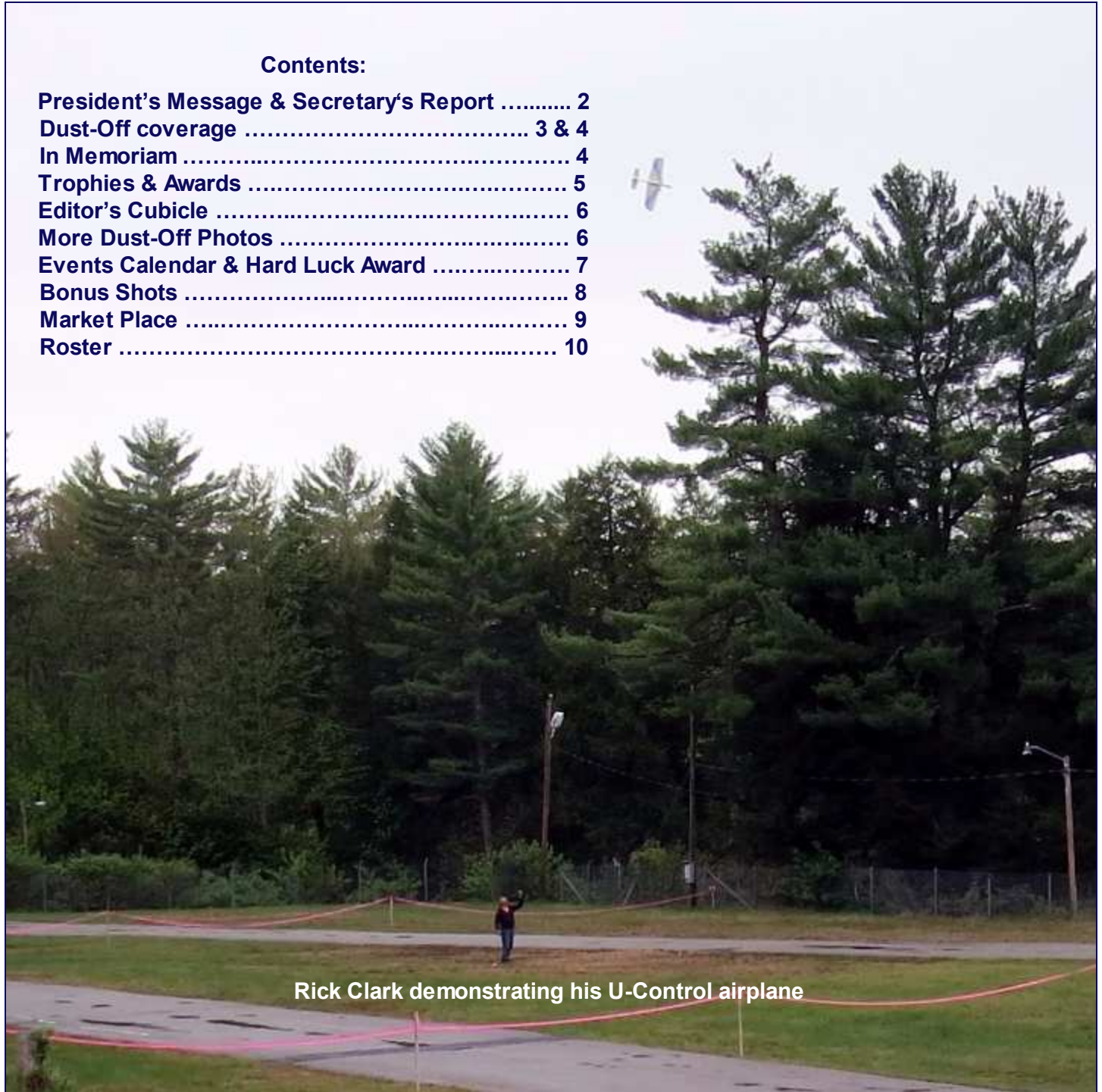

Janis made a motion to adjourn at 8:07 pm, seconded by Cecile and approved.

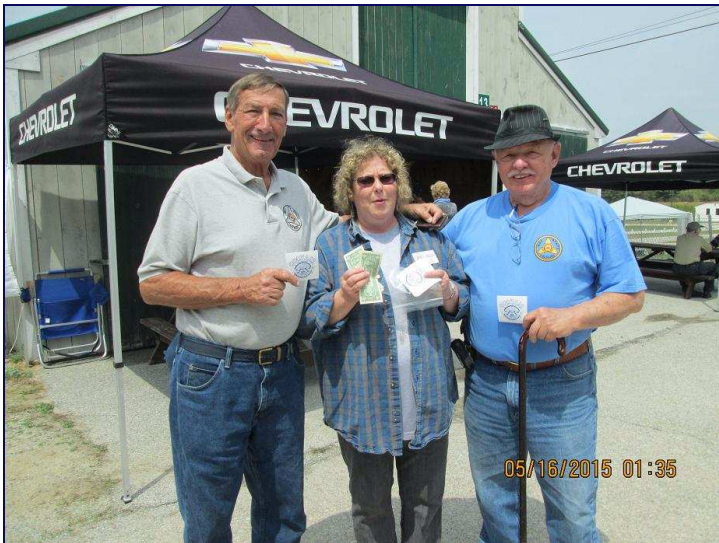

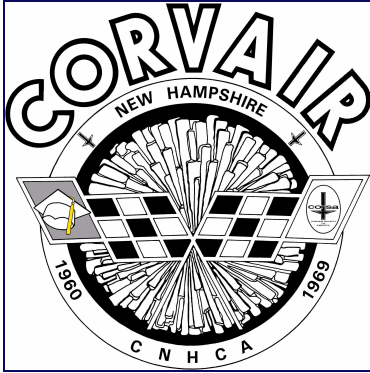

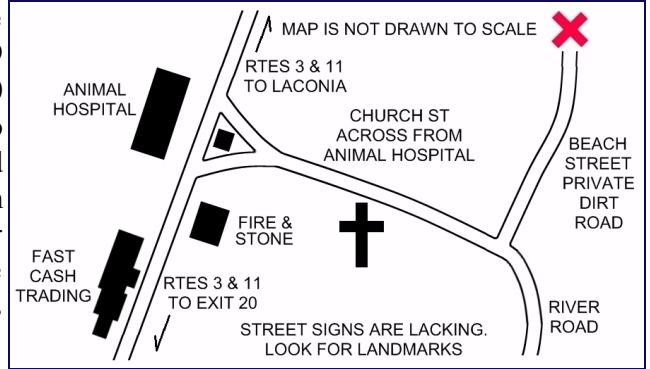
