Ron Mills and Vernon had a brief huddle on Saturday 6 April at Ron Kolakowski's house. They worked on Ron's 63 Spyder. Prior to wrenching, they hashed out a plan and they soon realized that it turned into a fairly comprehensive stem to stern inspection of Ron's car.

The Front End was inspected and they discovered a Pittman arm bushing had almost melted away. Ron Mills thinks he may have an extra bushing to offer if a rebuilding over a NOS is decided upon. After a lube of all but one fitting they moved on to a tire rotation. Ron has 13" radials that are becoming hard to find.

Next was the differential and transmission fluid change. The differential had a drain but the transmission didn't so after verifying that the fill/check ports weren't frozen we proceeded with the drain. Redline 80/90w Gl-4 was slowly applied with a small ketchup bottle to both transmission and differential.

As per the Corsa Tech guide's info on cooling, we removed the lower shrouds only to discover not only were they "empty" but the head temperature switch lead was broken.

An oil and filter change with Shell Rotella 10w30 and an E brake adjustment rounded out the day with a pizza break along the way.

While they accomplished quite a bit it became apparent that there are a few more items left to do.
