# **WMCC** History

Does anyone go to a mall anymore? They did back in the 1970s and 1980s. That was also when the West Michigan Corvair Club would put Corvairs on display in area malls. Looking back through old newsletters, it looks like our club participated in two or three mall shows every year. The malls included Eastbrook Mall, North Kent Mall, and Rogers Plaza. They would often bring the cars in on a Friday evening after the mall closed or Saturday morning before it opened so they would be on display for the weekend.

Here are some rules that participants needed to follow for a show at Eastbrook Mall in April 1978.

THOSE SHOWING CARS: We have 4 simple rules you must follow;

1. Please, no more than 1/4 tank of gas in the car.

2. Disconnect one or both battery cables, possibly take battery.

3. Bring a black large poly trash bag for use as a drip pan. 4. Take 4 small squares of rug, tile, metal, anything to put under each tire. Tire rubber reacts to floor treatment wax.

Below are some scans of pictures that I took at Rogers Plaza in 1983. They were taken with a Kodak Disc camera and I was only a kid so they are sort of off center.



We would also participate in quite a few parades every year. It seems there was always a holiday parade, or the Coast Guard Festival parade, or a parade related to a festival.
