

Bylaws  
of  
The Mid-Continent Corvair Association

Effective May 2002  
Revised May 2015

Article I. Name and Address

1. Name

- a. The name of the organization shall be the Mid-Continent Corvair Association (MCCA) hereafter referred to as the "Club".

2. Purpose

- a. Encourage interest in and aid in the preservation, restoration and operation of the Corvair automobile, trucks and related vehicles.
- b. Provide friendly social environment in which members can expand their knowledge and common interest of the Corvair.
- c. To promote sociability among its members, to hold and conduct meetings and activities which provide education and entertainment for members and their families.

3. Restrictions

- a. The Club shall be a non-profit, non-political, and non-partisan organization.

4. Affiliations

- a. The Club shall be maintained as a chartered chapter of CORSA, the Corvair Society of America.

5. Mailing Address

- a. The mailing address of the Club shall be designated by the Club, and shall be in a location accessible to the officers of the Club.
- b. The address shall be published in the monthly newsletter.

## Article II. Membership and Dues

### 1. Membership Types

1. Regular (full)
2. Life
3. Honorary
4. Non-dues paying

a. Membership shall be extended to all persons and their families interested in restoration, operation or enjoyment of the Corvair.

### 2. Dues

a. Members shall pay dues to the Mid-Continent Corvair Association as determined by the Club.

### 3. Membership Obligation

a. The member assumes the obligation to support the Club, its officers, and activities of the Association.

### 4. Membership Revocation (Termination of Membership)

a. Any membership can be terminated by a majority vote of the Board. No refund of dues will be made. Notice of proposed revocation must be printed in the newsletter prior to a vote being taken. The member whose membership is to be revoked will be provided written notification and has the right to submit to the club the reasons why his/her membership should not be revoked and to be present at the meeting where the vote is taken. The vote shall be by secret ballot.

## Article III. Officers

### 1. Officers

a. The Club shall have the following elected officers: President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

### 2. Election of Officers

a. The officers of the Club shall be elected annually by the membership.

(1) Candidates shall be active members of the Club who express a desire, or are willing to hold the office and carry out the respective duties of that office.

(2) Notice of Election shall be announced at the prior meeting. Any candidate selected may decline nomination at that time.

b. Any vacancy of officers shall be filled by appointment by the Board, subject to the approval of the majority of the members present at the general meeting following the announcement of the vacancy.

### 3. Restrictions of Officers

a. A member elected to the position of President or Vice President shall hold that position for no more than three consecutive one-year terms. After a one year break from the position, the member may be reelected to the same position with the same three consecutive term limit, as above.

b. Any officer can be removed from office by majority of all members when in the best interest of the Club.

c. Any member may decline to serve if nominated.

d. Any officer may resign by giving notice to all officers.

e. No officer shall receive compensation for services; however they may receive reimbursement for actual documented expenses.

f. When in the opinion of the President it is in the best interest of the Club, he/she shall be empowered to authorize expenditures of up to one hundred dollars with the approval of a majority of the officers, but without the approval of the Club membership.

## Article IV. Duties

### 1. President

a. The President shall be the principle executive officer and shall preside at all meetings and in-general supervise all business of the Club.

b. The President may sign with one other officer any contract, bond, deed, mortgage or title which has been authorized by the majority of the membership.

c. The President will represent the Club in matters pertaining to the operation of the Club.

### 2. Vice President

a. The Vice President shall function as the President in the absence of same.

b. The Vice President shall carry out all tasks assigned by the majority of the Board or the President.

### 3. Secretary

a. The Secretary shall handle all organizational correspondence.

b. The Secretary shall be responsible for recording the minutes of all formal Club meetings.

### 4. Treasurer

a. The Treasurer shall maintain the records of membership, dues, monies received and monies disbursed.

### 5. Editor

a. The Editor will create a newsletter in the best interest of the Club.

### 6. Committees

a. An auditing committee, of at least two Club members, excluding the Treasurer, shall be appointed annually to audit Club financial and physical assets. This committee shall report, in writing, to the President. This report shall be published in the newsletter.

b. Special Committees shall be appointed as required by the President. The committee shall serve until the project or requirement is complete.

### 7. Board of Directors

a. The Board of Directors (BoD) shall consist of current officers, the Editor, and two members-at-large who are elected by the membership.

## Article V. Meetings and Activities

### 1. Board Meeting

a. BoD meetings will be held as needed, at a time and location designated by the Board.

b. The BoD meetings will be primarily for the BoD, however all members are welcome to attend.

c. Any member may present business to be brought before the membership at the BoD meeting.



d. A quorum for transaction of business shall consist of at least four members of the BoD present at the BoD meeting.

## 2. General Meeting

a. General meetings shall be conducted on a monthly basis at a location designated by the BoD, unless substituted by a specific Club activity as designated by the BoD.

## 3. Activities

a. Activities such as rallies, econo-runs, tech sessions, picnics, car shows etc. will be scheduled as desired and in such a manner as to provide maximum opportunity for participation by all members.

# Article VI. Bylaws and Amendments

## 1. Bylaws

a. These bylaws will become effective upon publication to all members and upon a majority vote of the members present at the general meeting following publication in the Club newsletter.

## 2. Amendments

a. Any member can propose changes to these bylaws by doing so in writing to any officers of the Club.

b. Any proposed change must be published in the newsletter prior to a vote being taken.

c. Amendments will become part of the bylaws by a majority vote of the members present at the general meeting following publication of the proposed change in the newsletter.

## 3. Certification of Vote

a. Bylaws and Amendments will become official upon voting, and certification of the vote signed and dated by the President and the Secretary.
