
#### ON THE COVER:



He has taken this FC to Cree and had it varified to be an original. He purchased this FC in November of 1982 and is the fourth owner. It sleeps three, has a 2 burner gas range, gas refrigerator, awning and 12V and 120 lights. It is in good shape considering it has 69,000 miles and never been painted or taken good care of. This is an original Michigan FC.



Byron also sent along some information for installing a front spoiler on the FC without spending a bundle. It is made from an available GM truck spoiler. Installation time is about 12 hours easy but your lower sheet metal (body) should be pretty staight or you will have ripples or gaps.




