When I got home I had the pleasure of meeting Larry, Mary Schmuhl and Grand daughter Jessica


Larry Purchased the 64 Coupe I had listed in the Classifieds for Jessica and part of the deal I ended up with a pretty cool car lift!!

After all of that work, we are very satisfied with the basic layout, but short of extending the physical structure of an FC, interior room is usually at a minimum. Lynn and I often have to move things out of the way to make the bed, etc. One thing we found that was a great addition to our camping equipment arsenal was fleece sleeping bags. For summer camping, these things are excellent! They are not bulky and provide very comfortable bedding for warm summer evenings.



With the limited space issue in mind, I had looked for a utility trailer

for a few years. Lynn does not like the thought of a trailer behind the van, but I was able to talk her into it when I saw an ad for a Reese Backpacker trailer in the local newspaper's bargain counter. FC Mirrors

With all the recent chatter about F/C sideview mirrors, I thought I would throw in my 2 cents worth. On my 63 Rampy, I have a pair of beautiful sideviews that look great and fit PERFECTLY. I emphasize that word cause so many sideview mirror sets I see are terrible fits with body contour. The bases fit dead flat whereas you can fit a pencil through some of the uglies out there. I think they look better than the authentic West Coast Juniors and they have the advantage of being able to see over them whereas the originals create a huge blindspot. Only problem is you got to dig to find them. I found mine at the Hershey flea market and have seen more from time to time. You can probably find yours with an ad in Hemmings Motor News or with some queries to the numerous Ford vendors therein. The Ford part number stamped under the base is C8UB-17743 (RH) and 1744 (LH). They came in Chrome and silver paint, and they were imitated on the aftermarket. The mirror is separate from the arm. The mirror is 5 x 8. If I knew how. I would make a foto available online but I don't so I can't.
