



October 26, 2024 – Members and friends of the Lehigh Valley Corvair Club went on a Covered Bridge Road Tour! Six covered bridges in all.

Of the slightly more than 200 covered bridges still standing in Pennsylvania, seven examples are located in Lehigh County. We visited - and drove over - six of them.

Eleven Corvairs plus two non-Corvairs ran the tour, with twenty-four drivers & navigators. The weather was perfect, the Corvairs ran great, and we had good time.

The LVCC Covered Bridge Road Tour officially ended at The New Schnecksville Diner in Schnecksville, PA well into the afternoon. But some of us could not get enough!

Bob Weideman offered to lead us on a drive through the Trexler Nature Preserve which is located right off the route of the covered bridge tour. Andrew & Lauren Hewins and Allan & Joan Lacki took Bob up on his offer.

Formerly known as the Trexler-Lehigh County Game Preserve, the property is an 1,108-acre public park that is a focal point for land conservation efforts within Lehigh County, as well to protect endangered bison and elk. It's the access path to the Lehigh Valley Zoo.

We followed Bob through the preserve. It included a ford (not a Ford car, but a ford through Jordan Creek) and wonderful views from the hilltops. Luckily, the Jordan Creek was running low that day, so basically we just got our tires washed!

Big bonus - we saw a herd of bison standing behind a fence right next to the trail! (This place really is a "nature reserve)!

I think at one point before I got the car, rainwater was running into the tank from the gas cap area.




Gasoline stains are evident in this photo. (And that's Ken with his blue jeans leg, holding up the tank).

Corvair Institutional Knowledge

Al Unrath - one of our newest members and first-time Corvair owner - expressed concern about the potential loss of institutional knowledge in the Corvair community as our senior members age out.

It's a valid concern. But luckily, much of that institutional knowledge has already been preserved in books and video. Here's a run-down on where you can find it.

Dave "Motohead" Watson has dozens of Corvair repair videos on You-Tube. Don't be misled by his somewhat eccentric on-screen personality (his garage chicken, etc). Dave is actually a serious guy who really knows what he is doing. Here's a link to his YouTube catalog:

But that's not all. There are plenty of reference materials out there too, but you have to know where to look! All of the original Corvair shop manuals and assembly manuals from Chevrolet are in reprint. You can still buy them from Clark's Corvair Parts and several other Corvair vendors.

Well, the Pete Frailey V8 has been found! The following article is from the October 2024 issue of <u>Group Corvair Comments</u>, the official newsletter of the Group Corvair chapter of the Corvair Society of America. Editor Jim Simpson.

Pete Frailey and now Lee Hamilton's' V8 Car

A handful of Group Corvair members visited Lee Hamilton recently to take a look at Pete Frailey's V8 conversion. For those of you who don't know about the car, it was one of a handful of V8 conversions done by Art Silva in the late 1960s.



The Freiley / Hamilton V8. Customized in its early years, it has taillights from a 1970s Ford Capri.

Art realized that the aluminum Oldsmobile/Buick 215 cu. in. V8 weighed a bit less than the Corvair engine and, if converted to reverse rotation, would fit in the Corvair engine bay (with a few "minor" modifications).



Bare aluminum Oldsmobile cylinder block is there just to hold things together. The engine is a derivative of the aluminum Buick V8 engines offered in Skylarks and Specials from 1961 to 1963.

Pete Frailey loved to customize things and a custom V8 powered Corvair was right up his alley. Not long after the car was converted, but before really being finished, it was rearended and the engine damaged.

One thing led to another and Pete sold the car with it ending up in Lee Hamilton's possession. Lee repaired most of the damage and built a replacement engine, but then, once again, life intervened and progress has at least temporarily stalled.

Several of us had the opportunity to visit Lee and take some pictures. Hopefully the car will be rebuilt and another of Art Silva's creations will be back on the road again.


