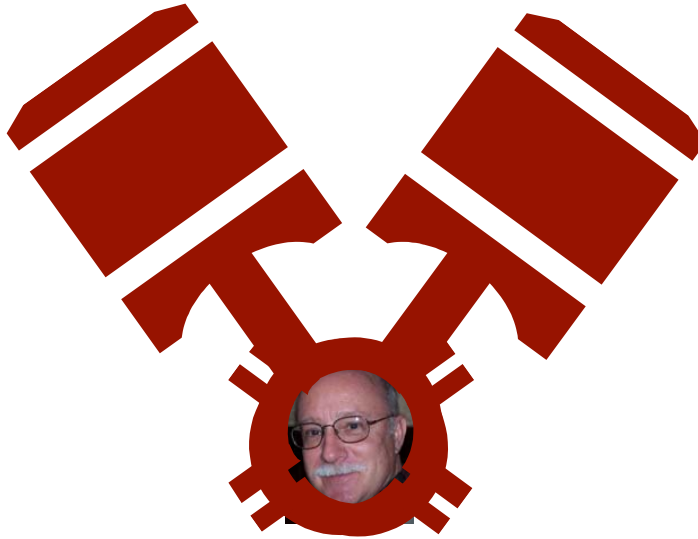
A "Piston" Packing Program Prepared by a Professional Pair of Prolific Presenters
