*Minutes of the 4th Quarterly Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:36 PM by Secretary Bob Marlow, in the absence of Acting President David Main.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the minutes from the 3rd Quarterly meeting were approved as published in the Fanbelt newsletter.

Treasurer Tim Schwartz reported the following club account balances as of October 31, 2008: Checking, \$5,643.97. Certificate of Deposit maturing May, 2009, \$1,511.61. Certificate of Deposit maturing August, 2009, \$3,649.50. Total, \$10,805.08.

*Activities VP Ken Schifftner provided an update on the planned group trip to the **Hunterdon Hills Playhouse** on January 31. Reservations must be submitted to him no later than the evening of the club Holiday Party on December 14.*

Publicity VP Greg Gorski reported that he is assembling a "library" of club newsletters and other materials, and that he is seeking materials from prior to 1983. The photo scrapbooks assembled by Roberta O'Neill and Rich Ribble in recent years are in the hands of Secretary Bob Marlow.

Acting President David Main arrived at this point.

NECC rep Brian O'Neill gave a quick recap of the 2008 events and planning for 2009. The meeting was adjourned at 8:09 PM and was followed by several games of NJACE "Bingo." Helen Gervasio and Jeff Ludwig won the first two games. Holiday Party December 14th - Rupert's Restaurant

The fun starts at 5 pm!!!!!!



This Year's Holiday Party at Rupert's Restaurant [directions are listed below]. For those of you who have attended the past few events, you probably remember the fun we've had with our Gift Game. For newcomers, or those of you who may have forgotten how this game works, here's a brief walk-through of the Gift Exchange rules. For starters, please keep gifts to a maximum monetary value of \$15.00. Since we will have guys and girls participating, unisex gifts work best. Finally, each gift has to be wrapped. All participants put one wrapped gift in the pile then, the participants each draw a number which determines the order in which they will choose a gift.

Gift Exchange Rules

- **Each participant draws a number.**
- **Number 1 picks a gift and unwraps it. Oohs and ahs or ha-ha-has as appropriate.**
- **Number 2 either takes ("steals") number 1's gift or picks a new one from the pile and unwraps it. If Number 2 has taken #1's gift, #1 takes a new one from the pile and unwraps that gift.**
- **Number 3 either takes #1's or #2's gift or picks a new one from the pile. Whoever's gift is taken, can then either take another person's gift or take a new one from the pile.**
- **For example: #8 takes #3's gift. #3 takes #5's gift. #5 takes #7's gift. #7 decides to take a new one from the pile. The round ends and we go on to #9.**
- **And so on.**
- **You cannot steal back a gift that has just been taken from you; you must wait at least one exchange and hope for another chance.**
- **For example, #8 takes #3's gift. #3 can't take it back, but they can take #5's gift. #5 takes #7's gift. #7 takes #3's gift. Then #3 can take #8's gift.**
- **You must take home whatever you end up with (or exchange it with or give it to someone else).**

Directions to Rupperts

From I-287: Southbound on Route 287, from Suffern, Mahwah or Oakland, take exit 53B for Route 23 North. Rupperts is in a shopping center about 3/4 of a mile on the right hand side.

-Northbound on Route 287 from Route 80 or points south, take exit 53B for Route 23 North. Rupperts is in a shopping center about 3/4 of a mile on the right hand side.

From I-80: From western New Jersey, take I 80 East to Route 287 North, follow directions for I-287 Northbound.

-From eastern New Jersey, take I-80 West to Route 23 North. Follow Route 23 North roughly 7 miles, Rupperts is on right about 3/4 mile past I-287.

- From Bergen County: From Paramus take Route 4 West to Route 208 North. Follow Route 208 to the end which runs into I-287 South. Follow directions above for I-287 southbound.
