**Moving** on to happier topics, Spring is here! Some years ago, Larry Ashley call this the start of car season and he was right. April offers numerous opportunities to get out and enjoy your Corvair, and two of these are NJACE Approved!

**On** Saturday, April 3, we will have our regular monthly breakfast meeting at the Pronto Deli on Ridgedale Avenue in **Cedar Knolls**. For those who may not have been to one of our breakfast gatherings, the location is in the Morristown area, just off I-287 and NJ Route 10, still very much the geographic center of our membership circle. The meetings are completely informal and each month we draw a chip to see which member will win a free breakfast. If the weather is nice, drive your Corvair, because we always have a tire-kicking session in the parking lot after breakfast.

**Later** in the month, on Saturday, April 24, our friends at VFW Post 5702 in Franklin Lakes are conducting an all-makes car show and automotive swap meet at their parking lot on the corner of Pulis Avenue and Franklin Avenue, also not far from I-287 and NJ Route 208. For the past two years we did our own April car show at the VFW location, but this year we are putting our support behind the VFWs own effort. This is not an official club event but all members are encouraged to either bring their cars are stop by to see the show.

**The** show runs 10 AM to 2 PM (although the lot opens at 8 AM for set-up), and is open to any type of car, truck, or motorcycle, with a \$5.00 entry fee. There will be music, drawings, food and drink, and there will be a Car of the Day trophy awarded. Swap meet spaces are available at \$30.00 each.

**Rain** date is Sunday, April 25, and proceeds benefit the Teaneck Armory Family Assistance Center. Our own Ken Schiffner is helping with this show, so come on out and show your support.

**Come** the following month, we have a similar schedule: Breakfast meeting on May 1, and then the big VCCA car show at McBride Field in Franklin Lakes on Memorial Day Sunday, May 30. The VCCA show is a Big Deal for several reasons. First, it is a large and well-established show, now in its 35th year. Second, this year, in honor of the Corvairs 50th anniversary, all Corvairs are the feature car. Corvairs will be in their own class, and arrangements are being made for several special exhibits, including a display engine and memorabilia from the Corvair Preservation Foundation.

**In** addition, NJACE is refunding the entry fee for all Corvair owners who sign up and bring their Corvair. Not just NJACE members, all Corvair owners. We want to attract a big field of Corvairs to this show. How will this work? Just print the registration form available from both the NJACE and VCCA web sites, fill it out, and send it in with your check. On the day of the show, when you arrive with your Corvair you will receive a cash refund of your entry fee, courtesy of NJACE.

**By** the way, NJACE members Dave Cavagnaro is a longtime member of the VCCA and is heavily involved in the show preparations. NJACE member Dave Main is also a VCCA member, and is helping to coordinate our club and the VCCA for this show.

**Speaking** personally, I have entered a car in this show at least five times through the years, and I can recommend it highly. It is a well-run, heavily-attended show. Ill be there, with my 1966 coupe, my Rampside, or both!

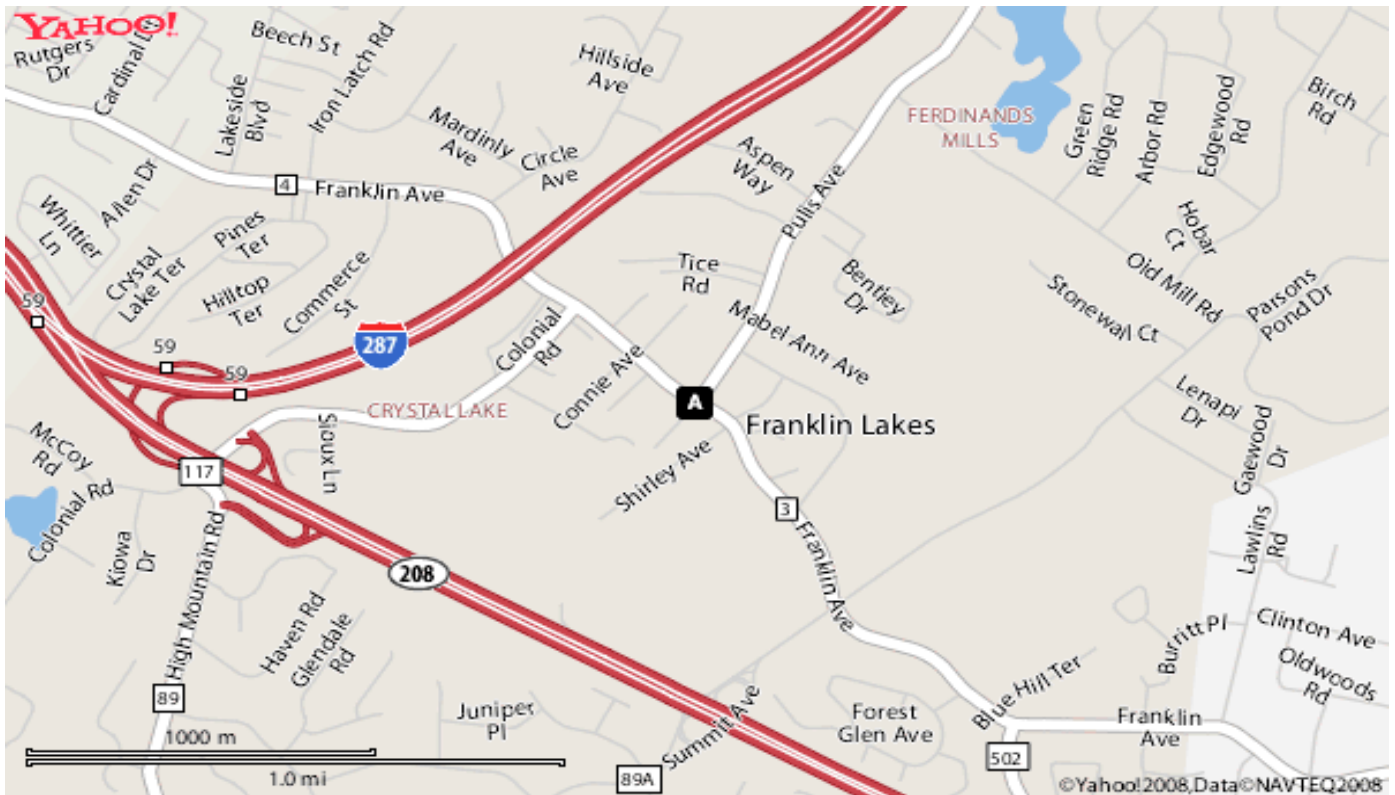
