Here you will find an abundance of information about the weekend including the Tentative Competitor Schedule, updated entry lists and Test Day schedules.

Please check the entry list, especially the Alpha list, to see if the Technical Director still needs information about your car (entry will state "Need RCIS" in the note column). Please contact Jack prior to your arrival. If you have not provided a transponder number with your entry, please supply one prior to arrival at the Nationwide Registration Building. If you have not provided the Registrar with a current racing medical exam date, please email that information ASAP.

Please email your messages to registrar@roadamerica.com as we are not available by phone. New and/or additional cars will be accepted at Registration beginning Wednesday, July 13 at 10AM.

As this is a once-a-year event and all registrars are not familiar with every participant, please be prepared to show your current race licensing ID at check-in. Also please have your crew prepared to show some type of ID.

Track Entry. You will be able to enter the staging area on Tuesday evening, July 12 at 5PM. If you are coming early, you may park (limited space) at the main gate entry off Highway 67. Paddock Parking will begin Wednesday, July 13 at 10AM and end at 6PM (exception is drivers who are participating in Wednesday's Test). If you arrive after 6PM on Wednesday you will be allowed to sign a waiver and proceed to the staging area to await Registration opening at 7AM Thursday morning. If for some reason you need to overnight your transport on Sunday following the event, you may do so – everything must be removed from the Paddock area and parked in the staging area for Sunday night.

Please be aware there is assigned paddock parking and these parking assignments will NOT be confirmed prior to arrival. We make every effort to ease the transition from Registration to your assigned paddock parking area. Please be patient if you are part of the 10AM rush. If you have a Team Name, your will be listed by the 1st letter of the Team Name. If not using a Team Name, you will be listed under the 1st letter of your Last Name (please advise crew and guests). When parking begins, you will be escorted to your site. The deadline for parking requests was JUNE 17 and every effort was made to fulfill your request. Two paddock parking passes will be given per driver for street vehicles.

If you feel there is an error on any part of your entry or if you need to make a change to your entry, please contact me via EMAIL, registrar@roadamerica.com, for the best response. Multiple changes to an entry may result in additional administrative fees.
