In Memorium...Richard Powers... By Dave Ellis March 8, 2025

Today was the Memorial Service for Richard Powers. We will miss Richard's being one of us... Richard led a VERY active and diverse life...husband, father, grandfather, UR Medical guru, Stromberg-Carlson Radio collector and expert, accomplished musician, quite successful Sports Car builder and racer, he even has a plaque in the sidewalk of fame at the Watkins Glen Racing Museum...Located a couple steps from another Rochester area racing legacy,,,Gary Morgan,,,and with all of that, he found room for our humble CORVAIR in his quite extensive stable of hobby/racing cars..

Richard got us hooked up with the ANNUAL MG CAR CLUB Show,,,initially held at the Victor High School complex...At some point the "bug" bit,,,and Richard had a raging case of "Corvairitis... 1966 CORSA TURBO COUPE, Aztec Bronze in and out...this was the one he most enjoyed,,,and also caused him the most heartache...He restored his first one top to bottom,,,easily a 90 point car at a CORSA National Concourse...that was until the huge tree branch fell on it in his yard in Irondequoit...

But,, I get ahead of myself.....My favorite Richard Powers story?? Summer of 1995, Acorns got an opportunity to do a "tour" of the Watkins Glen "long course"....we had about a dozen members bring out their cars to participate....We set up a photo op on the starting grid....Richard was positioned on the inside front row,, Dave Ellis and his recently restored 1966 Monza, 110 hp, PG Convert was right next to Richard.....We had a Track official lead us around a couple low speed "pace laps"...THEN,.. the pace car fellow told us he had to go to lunch,,,allowing us to take a couple laps on our own,,,and then, exit the track at the iconic pit entrance....WELLLLLL,,,you can imagine... it got a bit exciting.....I was on a tight left hander on the back side of the course,,,executing a perfect, counter steered broadside; with the PG maxed out in first gear,,,hitting the apex of the turn perfectly,,,when out of the corner of my right eye,,,I spot Richard passing me on OUTSIDE!!!screaming the turbo at redline in second gear,,,,moved past me at an amazing pace....I heard him upshift into 3rd as he passed me ,,,,and also head the distinctive whap whap of the fanbelt exiting its pulleys.....this was our last lap,,,so everyone calmly took the pit ramp and gathered together....Fortunately, I had my trusty KODAK snapshot camera closeby...I captured Richard standing behind his Coupe,,,deck lid raised,,,and holding the errant fanbelt up in his left hand... an ICONIC image...one that I passed onto Richard a couple years ago,,,as I was collating the ACORN PHOTO Archives...oh,,,to close the story...Richard put the same belt back on,,,set the tension,,,and successfully made the run back to Rochester from the Glen without incident!!!

Moving on,,,A couple months after the unibody crushing tree branch incident, Tom Nasman was able to supply Richard with a very solid California Corsa,,,IDENTICAL to the one that got crushed....Both vehicles patiently awaited their turn to receive the significant effort necessary to make one quality CORSA Turbo coupe from the two cars...However, life got in the way,,,and a couple decades passed as Richard procured allllll of the best quality components needed to accomplish the restoration...

I had the opportunity to spend an amazing visit with Richard about a month ago.... He volunteered to see if the VHS Cassettes the Acorns were gifted by Tom Martin were worth getting converted to SVD disk...I was delivering them to their new lovely home,,,with lots of garage space out back,,on Brighton,,, This turned out to be the last time I saw Richard,,,and it was soooo special.... I only wish I had been able to assist in the project of getting the restoration of his 1966 Corsa Turbo Coupe, Aztec Bronze in and out,,, brought to completion,,,,,

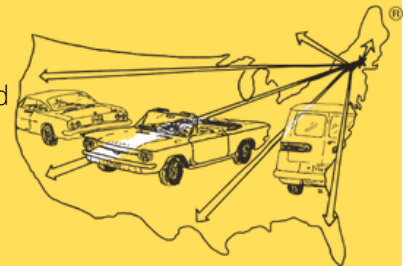

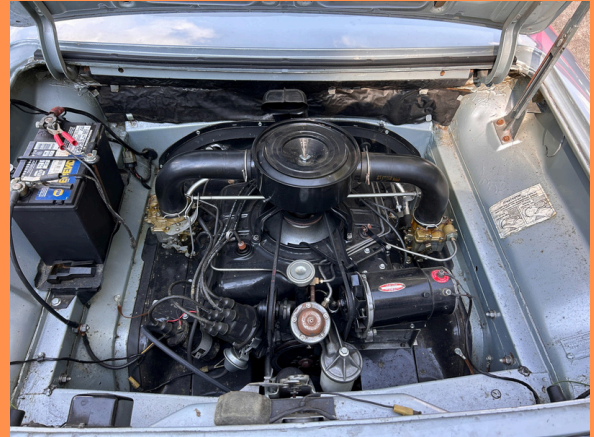

Below are the tools available in the CRIB, as of 11/1/2018

-(3 Available)- Hot "Valve Lash Adjustment Valve Covers", have 6 holes in the appropriate places for socket access

-Coil Spring Compressors (pair)

-UNISYNC- Carb Balancing Tool

-(3 Available)- Series 1, AXLE York Removal Tools, you will need a MAPP gas torch,,,and a big hammer too,....

-Oil Pressure Tester, Oil Filter Bolt fitted with flexible tubing to an Oil Pressure Gage...great to check/assure oil pressure when first firing up a brand newly rebuilt motor.....

-Grease Gun Adapter- for greasing HD Universal Joints that have grease fittings in place...

-(2 Available)- Steering Wheel Pullers

-Harmonic Balancer Pulley Removal Tool...works with the engine in normal position,,,just remove the Oil Filter...

-Valve Guide Removal Punch

-Wire Brush Reamer - to clean out cross-drilled holes in Crankshaft during a rebuild -Differential Side Gear Adjuster tool

-Piston Ring(s) Compressor, used when installing a Piston/Con Rod Assy into Jug, then attaching con rod to crankshaft

-Fan Bearing Greasing Tool

-(2 Sets Avail.)-12 tubes-(Enough for one side of the Motor)- to hold JUGS in place whilst installing Piston/Com Rod Assys into the jugs, and bolting up the connecting rod cap around the appropriate Crankshaft Journal...VERY helpful!!!

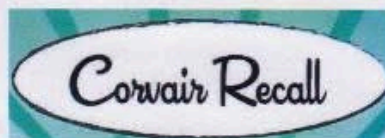
