In Memorium

CORSA Founder Richard M. Langworth CBE, 1941-2025
Richard Langworth, founder of the Corvair Society of America, passed away on February 20, 2025. Many years ago, in 1969, he ran an ad in Car & Driver magazine, asking readers who were interested in forming a Corvair club to get in contact with him. The response was overwhelming. Soon after, in March 1970, he chaired the CORSA's first organizational meeting at his home in Camp Hill, Pennsylvania.

After CORSA got up and running, Mr. Langworth went on to other pursuits involving different car clubs and a became a distinguished author, having written at least 45 books (not counting magazine and journal contributions), including several about the life and times of Winston Churchill.

- -(3 Available)- Hot "Valve Lash Adjustment Valve Covers", have 6 holes in the appropriate places for socket access
- -Coil Spring Compressors (pair)
- -UNISYNC- Carb Balancing Tool
- -(3 Available)- Series 1, AXLE York Removal Tools, you will need a MAPP gas torch,,,and a big hammer too.,....
- -Oil Pressure Tester, Oil Filter Bolt fitted with flexible tubing to an Oil Pressure Gage...great to check/assure oil pressure when first firing up a brand newly rebuilt motor.....
- -Grease Gun Adapter- for greasing HD Universal Joints that have grease fittings in place...
- (2 Available)- Steering Wheel Pullers
- -Harmonic Balancer Pulley Removal Tool...works with the engine in normal position,,,just remove the Oil Filter...
- -Valve Guide Removal Punch
- -Wire Brush Reamer to clean out cross-drilled holes in Crankshaft during a rebuild -Differential Side Gear Adjuster tool
- -**Piston Ring(s) Compressor**, used when installing a Piston/Con Rod Assy into Jug, then attaching con rod to crankshaft
- -Fan Bearing Greasing Tool
- -(2 Sets Avail.)-12 tubes-(Enough for one side of the Motor)- to hold JUGS in place whilst installing Piston/Com Rod Assys into the jugs, and bolting up the connecting rod cap around the appropriate Crankshaft Journal...VERY helpful!!!


