


The car and the wheels look Great.









We started by checking out the work done on Byron's Convertible and looking at Art's 1965 Monza four door.





Two Corvairs at the meeting and nine members attending (A.J., Art, Bob, Brian, Byron, Darrin, Doug, Mark, & Pete) with the project being, to assemble Byron's 140HP engine that will go into the Convertible when done. It was a Hot day. The crew started by using a tap and die to clean up the head studs and all threads in the aluminum block. All gasket surfaces were checked and cleaned up. The Corvair Ranch had already dipped the block so it was Great to work with. After all the fine tune clean up, Byron sprayed carb-cleaner and used compressed air to further clean up the block halves, and the crankshaft.












The block was torqued to spec with some Plastigauge on the main bearings and cam and then taken apart and clearances checked. All good. Before final assembly, and with the block halves apart, this was the time to check bearing clearance on the rod journals. Easy to get to them as seen in this picture since they have not been installed into the jugs yet.



With that done, (about 2:25pm) the crankshaft and cam were lined up and block halves were torqued together by Byron and Mark while Pete used the rubber mallet to impact the block while torquing. The crank turned smoothly. The garage was too nice for us to leave Byron with a block on the floor so we installed the bell housing and put the engine on his engine stand. Thirty minutes later we had it running. HA.. Must be the heat°.



Upgraded suspension parts for the LM by Brian Brooksby

Here are the pictures of the complete LM suspension upgrade made by Nate Wolfe. I've driven his cars equipped with this set up and they handle like slot cars. I've received all the parts and they are top notch.

Front control rod replaced with adjustable Johnny joint. Front Lower arm greasable USA made ball joint, and spherical joint. Rear control arm with spherical bearing that no longer requires the small connecting rod as the control arm is locked down with no side to side movement.
