The 2022 trans that we put in, developed a problem, so Bob sent the trans we took out in 2022 to be rebuilt and set up a February 2023 Club meeting at Fred's Garage to put it in using the same method of leaving the engine installed and dropping the Front of the drive train down to remove the transmission. Bob had brought a 1965(4 hole) trans to diff gasket with him and had to go back home for the correct(6 hole) 1966 trans to diff gasket. (His 65 Corsa has a 66 Transaxle in it.)





When I arrived at Fred's driveway I saw Bob backing down in Fred's truck to go get the gasket, so I pulled into the neighbors driveway to turn around. When I put my Saturn's manual transmission into reverse, the trans cable bushing broke and I could Not get it out of reverse. I had to get it towed by AAA. Thanks to a Saturn Forum, I found that a guy on eBay (saturnbushingman) makes a Delrin replacement bushing for \$20 and has a Lifetime warranty. Less than 30 minutes after getting the bushing I had it installed and was back on the road. Shows the importance of Forums and Clubs.

We had a good turnout of members to help out. Bob found that the left rear wheel bearing was loose and will need to be replaced. That would be the time to replace the 1965 short bolt yokes with 1966 long bolt yokes to match the 1966 differential in the Corsa.





A little persuasion was needed to separate the trans from the differential.



There were a total of 5 Corvairs in attendance.

We got another in person update on Gary's 1968 coupe rear window channel metalwork.











Upgraded suspension parts for the LM by Brian Brooksby

Here are the pictures of the complete LM suspension upgrade made by Nate Wolfe. I've driven his cars equipped with this set up and they handle like slot cars. I've received all the parts and they are top notch.

Front control rod replaced with adjustable Johnny joint. Front Lower arm greasable USA made ball joint, and spherical joint. Rear control arm with spherical bearing that no longer requires the small connecting rod as the control arm is locked down with no side to side movement.


Rust and Rodent Nests

The tragic long-term demise of over six dozen Corvairs

On Saturday, 25 February 2023, on the northeast edge of Carthage, Missouri, there was an Estate Auction. They were selling everything outside the house – shop tools and equipment as well as the cars, trucks, tractors, boats, motorcycles, etc. What got my attention was that the sale bill started out, "Approximately 80 Antique Corvair Cars, Trucks & Vans. No autos are running. All are for parts or salvage. Some have titles; majority do not." Being only 90 miles from me, my youngest Grandson and I had to go check it out.

After arriving at the auction site and getting my registration number, we proceeded to the field where the cars were parked. It became readily apparent that "parts or salvage" was almost an understatement.

The first nine attached pictures show the field of mostly Corvairs, with other makes mixed in. But even before you got this far, the first thing you saw after walking from the registration trailer toward the car field was the back half





Many of the Greenbriers and vans were being used for storage. The back and top of one wasn't being used for anything except as an umbrella for its long-removed engine.





Yes, they had a few cars that, in better days, would have been good parts sources – a couple of early Spyders and a late Monza 4-carb 140. There were also a couple of Lakewoods.

As I was making my tour, I kept three things in mind:

One, I learned many years ago that rodent urine and feces are highly corrosive to metal, especially aluminum. It was obvious as I walked around in that field that rodents had been inhabiting these cars for a very long time. On one '77 AMC Matador sedan

that had the hood still down, I opened it just to check out the engine, and the entire engine compartment was one huge rat nest. I even surprised one of the large rodents still lying in the top of the nest, who promptly scurried back towards the firewall and down a nest hole above the left-front wheel well.

Two, the engines wouldn't turn. I brought a long box-end wrench with me and tried to rotate the crankshafts of most of the engines in the cars that still had them, especially the Spyders and 140. No luck.

And three, I wondered how many of these Corvairs were operational 'junk' when they arrived in the yard. It was looking like most of them were.

One of the cars listed in the sale bill was a "1961 Buick Skylark w/Aluminum V8 motor." I had read stories of how these engines made great Corv-8 conversions, so I was really interested in that non-Corvair. But when I got to it, the hood latch was jammed, and the hood wouldn't open. It probably hadn't been raised in many years. Remembering what I saw with the '77 Matador, I walked away. I didn't want to haul this car home, get the hood opened, then watch three generations of rodents scatter across my property.

So, after doing a fairly complete inspection and deciding I didn't really need any of these "parts", we left. The auctioneer was running late with the small stuff anyway, and I couldn't see hanging around three or four more hours for something I wasn't going to buy.


A truly interesting but disappointing afternoon. I've been interested in Corvairs since I read the first *Motor Life* preview story in the summer of 1959, and in the ensuing 64 years, I never dreamed one individual could mistreat so many Corvairs for so long.
