The event brought out four members Corvair's to listen to their kin, once removed, come to life.





Before the 140 engine was brought outside, Bryan, with his converted-to-a-tool distributor shaft, used it with a drill to build up oil pressure while Byron turned the crank over one rotation so all journals got hit with oil. With one more rotation, it was back to #1 cylinder at TDC so the distributor went in with Jimmy's borrowed Point's Plate.

I brought my 140 Extractor dual exhaust system so they could be rotated under the engine in case the valves needed to be adjusted. Byron gave me the exhaust donuts that came in the 140 kit from Clark's and for a minute there, I thought I got the wrong 110 Extractors by mistake. The Clark's donuts were TOO BIG for the 140 manifold to pipe. They would have worked but the manifolds did not have studs and we did not have long enough bolts to attach them anyway. SO. . . At least 4 of us, who went to Summit Point the Saturday before, had our ears conditioned for this.


Byron had an In-Tank electric fuel pump on a sending unit and he put it into the gas can and accidentally hooked up + & - to both ends of the ground wire and a PUFF of smoke emanated from the wire just Outside of the gas can and Aged us All by a month or two.

After a few deep breaths and with the pump working, the carbs were primed. Jimmy and Byron checked the new fuel lines for leaks and only had two areas that needed to be fixed. Jimmy went through the process of adjusting All four carbs so primary's and secondary's opened correctly.





After a few weak cranks we ended up using TWO sets of jumper cables and jumped Jimmy's battery in his running Corvair to the engine and we had enough power then, and got the engine RUNNING.



Bob M, Bob W, Jimmy and Mark each brought a starter motor. We were determined to get it running! With a successful run of the engine, it was rolled back into the garage and the air filters were fitted. Looking Good!

Just waiting for his Convertible to get home.









Before Bob M. left in his 1965 Corsa I got a look at his freshly rebuilt Front Suspension. Handles like a new car now.

There were three fire extinguishers placed around during start up so we were prepared. This is a Great extinguisher to keep in your Corvair whenever traveling. It does not leave any residue and makes for easy cleanup after.

Once mine is created I can supply photos and have the price locked down, though I'm guessing \$150-175 range.


I look forward to the selection of mufflers available in a more standard size.



Here are the pictures of the complete LM suspension upgrade made by Nate Wolfe. I've driven his cars equipped with this set up and they handle like slot cars. I've received all the parts and they are top notch.

Front control rod replaced with adjustable Johnny joint. Front Lower arm greaseable USA made ball joint, and spherical joint. Rear control arm with spherical bearing that no longer requires the small connecting rod as the control arm is locked down with no side to side movement.






