You might not know that Joe has been involved in ballooning for quite a long time. He and his wife, Kelli own the balloon, Evil Twin. Here is Joe's story in his own words:



I was born at a very early age...

My ballooning career began in 1995 when I volunteered as chase crew for Balloon Fiesta. They assigned me to help Don Boyer, a pilot out of Belen. I guess you could say we hit it off because 30 years later, we co-own the balloon and I'm his crew chief. I have been to every Balloon Fiesta since 1995, traveling from Virginia, Texas, and even Hawaii to attend. It's my favorite 9 days of the year. Don taught my wife Kelli to fly and she flies the balloon during Balloon Fiesta while he flies a sponsor balloon.

In 2014, after 19 years of being chase crew at Balloon Fiesta, I wanted to see Fiesta from a different perspective. I applied to be a Launch Director (Zebra) and got accepted into the dazzle (that's what a group of zebras is called...really!). We are all volunteers and we have the most fun of anybody (well, except for maybe the pilots). Our job is to conduct a safe, coordinated launch. No one takes off until a Zebra gives them permission. We approach the basket and give a quick scan to make sure things look ok. We give a short briefing to the pilot as to the launch procedures, checking the sky upwind to see if any balloons are heading our way. We also look to both sides to see what other balloons (and Zebras) are doing; we try to coordinate the launches so the balloons take off in nice, neat rows (not always possible!). When it's time, I run downwind from the balloon, tweeting my whistle to clear spectators from the path. I turn around, scan the sky for balloons approaching from upwind, and when it's safe, I give 3 long blasts on the whistle and give a big thumbs up with my hands high in the air. I watch the balloon fly overhead to observe it's speed and direction so I have an idea of where the next balloon will go. Then it's on to the next balloon.

We have around 60 Zebras in the dazzle, including 4 leaders. It's a team effort...each Zebra is assigned to a particular row, either North Section or South Section (I'm Row 2, South Section). However, we have the authority to take care of a balloon out of our row as necessary. Other than Fiesta, we take the balloon to Gallup twice a year for rallies and Belen for the Saint Patrick's Day rally. We are members of the Albuquerque Aeronaut

Ascension Association (AAAA) and Valencia Flying and Retrieval Society (VFRS) balloon clubs. –Joe Ballengee



A Moment of Pride—The State Fair Reimagined

I'll start this tale with a question. What would you think if the Albuquerque State Fair suddenly disappeared from Albuquerque and was moved to somewhere yet to be determined? This was just one of the issues discussed at a public meeting recently hosted by the organization "Our Fairgrounds Reimagined". This planning group was funded by the New Mexico State Legislature to put together a plan for bringing major changes to our State Fair including, maybe even moving it to another city. I attended the meeting along with fellow Board member, Angela Vigil to find out what was happening.

Sadly, the presentation left a lot of questions unanswered. The major question to me, the moving of the Fair, described in news accounts, was aptly dodged by the meetings organizers. Their response to questions about relocation were met by a vague reply that could be summed up by the phrase, "We don't know, and anyway that would be years off and maybe not happen." Not a response calculated to reassure the public about the Fair's future. However, I am not here to "trash" the session, but to let you know about the moment that Angela stepped up for all us car folks.

The meeting was filled with discussions and descriptions of what changes could come to the Fair. This included references to entertainment venues, gross receipts taxes, and other related issues I now tend to forget. But what I can't forget is what Angela had to say. When it was her turn, Angela stepped up to the microphone to make her point. That point was that if the "powers" actually push forward and move the Fair to another area they would be leaving the very popular weekend car shows behind. She noted that members of the extensive Albuquerque car community would probably not be willing to drive to a more remote location, say Moriarty or Los Lunas. I would count myself as one of those who

would be missing in the future. I should point out that I've served as show chairman of the Corvair Club's show for almost 30 years, so my decision to step away would not come easily.

Angela's observation was met by polite silence from those on the stage. It was readily aware to me that the impact on the shows was not very much a part of their plans. I want to thank Angela for her advocacy on the part of the Albuquerque car community. Maybe this will help keep those car shows here... but maybe not. We'll have to see if anyone was paying attention.—Robert Gold
