#### Sunday, October 10:

**Sparta Historical Society Car Show**. It's the *6th Annual Antiques & Classic Car Show* headed up by NJACE President Brian O'Neill. It take place at the Van Kirk Museum, 336 Main Street, Sparta, NJ and runs from 11:00 AM through 3:00 PM.

The show theme this year is "Orphaned Cars" and so Corvairs will fit right in! People's Choice Awards. The event includes an open house at the Van Kirk Homestead Museum with its Fall Exhibit on homespun arts, including on this day only, homespun arts demonstrators, such as the Lost Lacers, quilters, weavers, spinners, knitters, etc. Food by VFW available for purchase.

#### Sunday, October 24:

**"Motorama" Car Show**, presented by our friends at the Jersey Lake Region VCCA. Postponed from 2020, **this show will celebrate the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Corvair**. It takes place at the High Mountain Middle School ball field, 515 High Mountain Road, North Haledon, NJ and runs from 8:00 AM through 4:00 PM.

In celebration of the 60th anniversary of the introduction of the Chevrolet Corvair, Corvairs will have their own parking area and special free raffle. The first 20 to register will receive a free wall plaque commemorating their participation.

There will be 30+ trophies awarded, in the categories of Top 25 vehicles (stock & modified), Top 3 Survivors, Best Paint, Best Engine, Best Interior, Best Corvair, Special Interest, and more. Participants will also receive goodie bags, dash plaques (first 200 to arrive), and a chance to win door prizes.

The show field closes at noon, or earlier if full. Day-of-show registrations are welcome but once the show field is full, no additional day-of-show registrations will be permitted. (However, all pre-registered car spaces will be held until noon no matter what.)
