HEATER FAN TECH TIP

HAVE A LOW OUTPUT HEATER FAN? YES, CLARK'S HIGH OUTPUT BLOWER WORKS WELL AND IS A DIRECT REPLACEMENT. HOWEVER, CHECK YOUR EXISTING BLOWER SQUIREL CAGE FOR INSULATION FROM THE REAR DECK LID PAD BEFORE REPLACING OR BUYING A HIGH OUTPUT MODEL. MY 1966 COUPE SUFFERED FROM LOW OUTPUT AND AFTER DISASSEMBLY I FOUND THE EXISTING BLOWER WAS COATED WITH INSULATION THUS REDUCING BLOWER OUTPUT [MUCH LIKE A LINT TRAP ON A DRYER]. CHECK YOURS FIRST BEFORE BUYING THAT REPLACEMENT.

LETS GET READY FOR SUMMER

THE FOLLOWING TIPS SHOULD PROVIDE FOR MANY MILES OF TROUBLE FREE SUMMER MOTORING.

FIRST ON THE LIST AND OFTEN OVERLOOKED IS FIXING THE SUMMER/WINTER COVER INTO THE SUMMER POSITION. THAT IS, HAVING THE COVER OVER THE SHROUD OPENING BELOW AND TO THE REAR OF THE OIL COOLER WITH THE METAL EXTENSION OR LEG HOLDING THE HOT AIR EXHAUST TRAP DOOR OPEN ABOUT 1/2" TO 1" WITH THE ENGINE COLD. FAILURE TO USE THE COVER AND LEAVING THE HOLE IN THE SHROUD UNCOVERED WILL RESULT IN HEATED EXHAUST AIR BEING RECYCLED INTO THE ENGINE COMPARTMENT, NOT THE MOST DESIRABLE THING ON A 90 DEGREE JULY WEEKEND.


SECOND BUT NO LESS IMPORTANT IS CLEANING THE OIL COOLER. FIRST REMOVE THE COVER WHICH IS HELD IN PLACE BY SHEET METAL SCREWS. NEXT PICK OUT ANY LOOSE MATERIAL BY HAND, THEN USE A SMALL BRUSH TO DISLODGE ANY REMAINING SOLIDS. THIRD BLOW DOWN THROUGH THE COOLER WITH COMPRESSED AIR. FINALLY REINSTALL THE COVER.

A THOROUGH INSPECTION OF THE FAN BELT, BLOWER BEARING, TENSION PULLEY, AND BELT GUIDES IS NEXT ON THE LIST. ANY EVIDENCE OF FRAYING, CRACKS, OR GLAZED SHINY APPEARANCE ON THE BELT MEANS REPLACE IT NOW. DON'T WAIT UNTIL YOU'RE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE FOURTH OF JULY PARADE FOR THE OLD BELT TO GIVE OUT. USE THE SHOP MANUAL FOR SPECS ON BELT TENSION AND THE BELT GUIDE ADJUSTMENTS!


NOW IS A GOOD TIME TO CHECK YOUR SPARE FAN BELT. A FEW YEARS OF STORAGE UNDER THE SPARE TIRE OR BEING STUFFED UNDER THE HEADLIGHT BUCKET IN THE TRUNK CAN TAKE ITS TOLL ON EVEN THE BEST QUALITY BELT. WHAT??? YOU DON'T HAVE A SPARE BELT?!?! WELL UNTIL YOU'VE THROWN A BELT ON THE PENNSYLVANIA TURNPIKE 30 MILES FROM THE HEAREST SERVICE PLAZA, YOU CAN'T APPRECIATE THE IMPORTANCE OF CARRYING A SPARE BELT AND THE TOOLS TO CHANGE IT.

BY FOLLOWING THESE FEW HINTS AND USING COMMON SENSE, YOU SHOULD BE ABLE TO ENJOY YOUR CORVAIR FOR MANY MORE SUMMERS TO COME.
