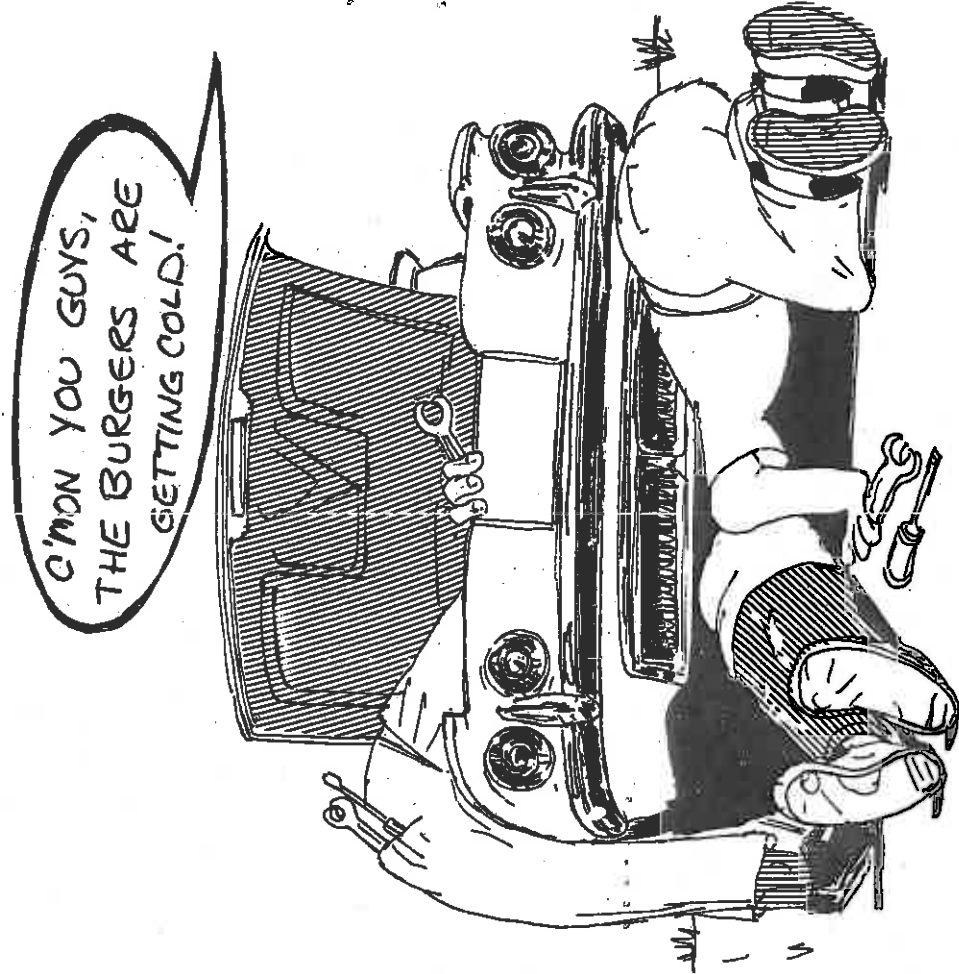

1987 OFFICERS PRESENT: PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, SECRETARY AND TREASURER

SUNDAY MAY 24

THE TOUR TAKES ABOUT AN HOUR AND A HALF-OUR GROUP IS TO BE ASSEMBLED TO START AT 1:30 SHARP. THE COST IS \$1.00 FOR ADULTS AND .50 FOR CHILDREN.

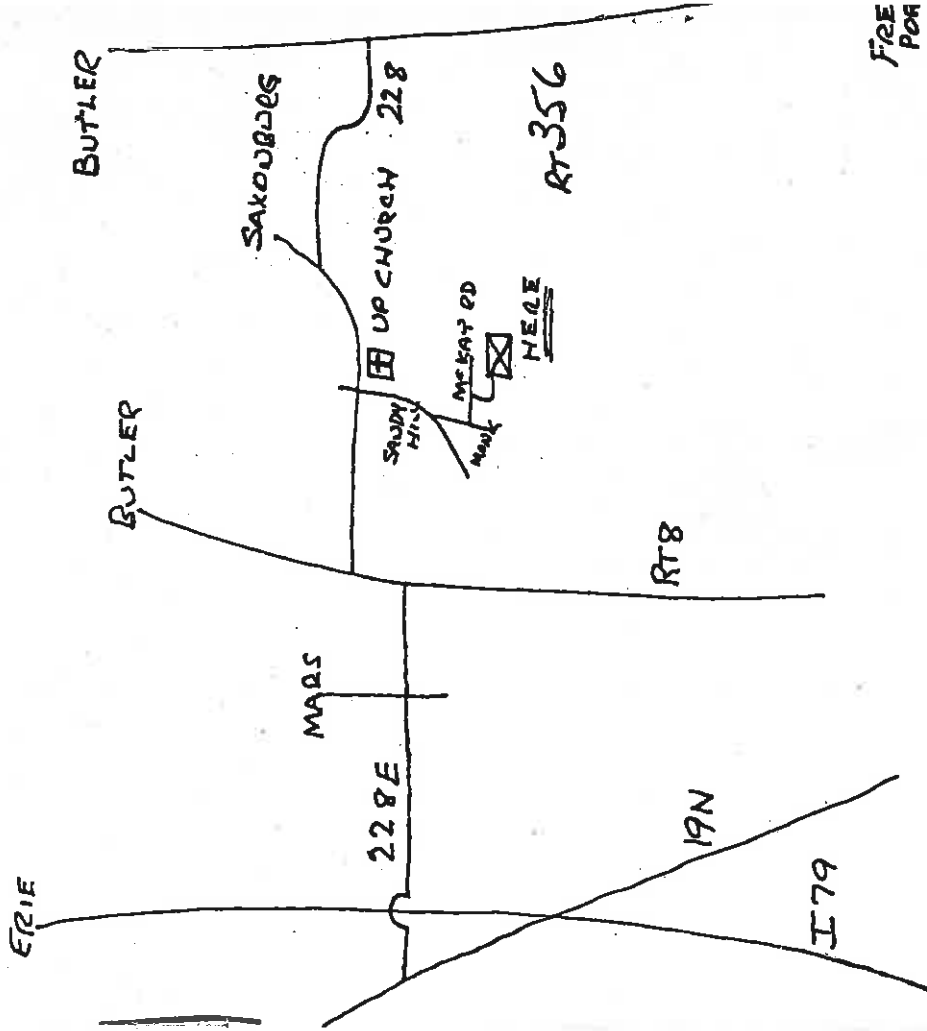
FIVE YEARS AGO IN THE JOURNAL

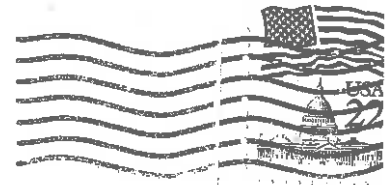
