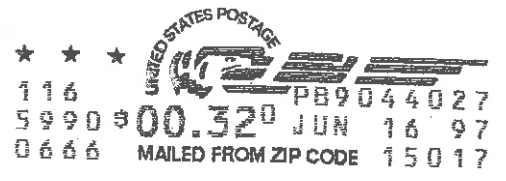
NOTICE - SECOND QUARTER MEETING - June 24th.
