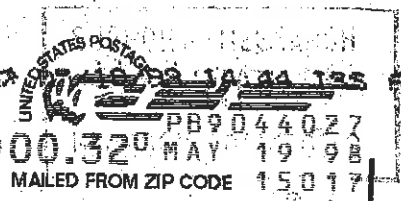
Steve, our president, lives in Chicora. If he can make the meeting, why can't you? Give it a shot / you'll like it.
