Here's something to think about though—the number of Corvair people is dwindling each and every year; there are fewer and fewer of us to support the Corvair hobby, which means we have to do it with less money. It also means we need some fresh young blood in the hobby. The fact remains, last year alone,

the cost to mail the *Journal* was \$120. If you turn back to the financial report on page 3 and add up the entries for *Vair Street Journal Expenses*, you would find that it cost roughly \$400 to print and mail the Journal in 2007.

We think it's important for you to know what's going on in your club. We do some darned nice events and we hope that you'll join us once in a while. In the mean time, if you have a computer and would be willing to receive your copy of the Vair Street Journal electronically, send me your e-mail address, and I'll be pleased to send you the **Electronic Journal**.
