
Jim presented the 'Member of the Year' trophy to Tim Desmond and thanked him for his work in putting together the blueberry picking events.

Next stop was the dining room for hor d'oeuvres, drinks and talking with old friends.



Pat Greenwald and friend, Dolly Izzo, again did the honor of hosting the Chinese Auction.


The party was loads of fun; good times with a great bunch of oldies.

Heidi Madden and Mary Ellen Cekus watch Don Cekus' technique for dropping tickets in cups







I'll leave the disposition up to you, or perhaps the president.


