



LOW COST - \$2.00 concours fee, (\$3.00 day of show). Reduced price prints at a nominal party. Free raffle during Saturday evening.


CONVENIENT - Two miles from Turnpike. Walk to everything, or ride the mall shuttle. Early check out time. Chartered bus, not your car, for the tour.
