become CORSA members. So far, Central Division Director Jamie Reinhart has introduced one proposal (outlined in last month's Directors Turn at the Wheel) that calls for three membership levels, one for basic membership with no Communique, a mid level membership with electronic delivery of the Communique, and the third membership level consisting of a printed copy of the newsletter. Each membership level would have a different level of dues as well. While this does not require 100% of the chapter members to be CORSA members, it does encourage chapter members who can't afford the full dues, an option to join CORSA for a lesser price.

Another option that I have introduced would eventually lead to 100% CORSA membership. All new chapter members would be required to become CORSA members, but if you are currently a chapter member who is not a CORSA member, then you would not be required to become a CORSA member unless your chapter membership lapses, then you would be treated as a new member and be required to join CORSA. Chapter members who are currently CORSA members would be required to maintain their CORSA membership for as long

as they are chapter members. Additionally, adjustments in the dues would be made based upon the method of delivery for the Communique, but this would be handled as a separate topic once the membership issue is resolved. The Board is preparing to tackle this issue so please, if you're passionate about CORSA, contact your Directors and let them know your thoughts on the subject.

On another front, CORSA is in the beginning stages of revamping the CORSA web site. We're in the process of getting quotes from external sources for developing and maintaining a much more robust web presence. A number of ideas are being considered to add functionality, improve timeliness of the content, and make navigating the site much more intuitive. Again, if you have any ideas or recommendations on this topic, pick up the phone or send an e-mail to your Directors.

We've got some new, and young blood on the Board and the motivation seems to be there to make the necessary changes. The time for hard decision is here, and with your input and guidance, I'm sure the Board will make the right decisions.
