Dear WPCC Member,

We are very aware that not all of our members attend WPCC meetings and functions, but we still feel a need to do our very best to serve you without imposing on the way you chose to be a member. However, we'd like to think that if you came to a meeting or attended one of our events, you would get more bang for your \$12 membership buck that you so graciously give to preserve the Corvair hobby.

Because of increased postage and printing costs the *Vair Street Journal* is published bi-monthly. Consequently, notifying or reminding people of upcoming meetings and events is less than ideal. People sometimes forget to write noteworthy dates on their calendar or store the information in that marvelous memory bank inside their head.

Today, only a small percentage of people in United States are without access to a computer. E-mail is used by millions of people every day. Currently, WPCC members use e-mail to communicate with each other and to submit the material, both copy and digital pictures for publication in the *Vair Street Journal*.

So what's my point? Roughly 46% of our members show an e-mail address on the roster that is published in every issue of the Journal. That's not a problem. All I ask in return is that you simply type WPCC in the SUBJECT box of your e-mail. 




